4. Eligibility & Physicals

- According to GHSA policy, students must not be failing more than 2 classes in a semester to remain eligible for athletics
- Credit requirements: 2.5 credits earned in previous semester with a total of:
 - Sophomores - 5
 - Juniors - 11
 - Seniors - 17
- All athletes must have an UPDATED physical uploaded and approved in RankOne before they can participate in pre-season conditioning or tryouts
 - RankOne instructions and printable physical forms are linked on the Lanier High School website on the athletics page on the *forms* tab

5. Student Athlete Responsibilities

- GRADES: you must be passing 5 out of 7 classes
- ATTENDANCE: students who are consistently tardy/absent are subject to be ineligible to tryout/dismissed from team per coach's discretion

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- c. BEHAVIOR: students represent the Lanier Soccer program inside and outside the building

6. Tryouts Information

- a. Tryouts (and practices) are held at Lanier HS
 - i. In few instances, practices may be held at Gary Pirkle Park
- b. Players MUST be picked up from tryouts/practice on time.
- c. Athletes need to bring: water, shin guards and cleats
- d. In the instance that tryouts/practices are held at Gary Pirkle Park, there will be bus transportation from LHS to the park on school days
